Dear Parents/Carers,

In the everchanging climate we find ourselves in, we would like to put the following steps into place.

At this stage, the advice we have to follow is: The School remains open. However:

If your child is health compromised, asthma, heart condition, diabetic etc, we recommend you keep them at home. If your child/ren comes into regular contact with someone at home with one of the above conditions, we recommend that they stay at home.

Under these circumstances, it is your right, as a parent to make the judgement call on whether to send your child to school, or not.

Because we now have half of the school population staying at home and many more indicating they will be keeping their child/ren at home, we have decided to institute the following.

Thursday and Friday will be pupil free days: those of you who cannot make alternative arrangements and if you are in essential services, you can still send your child/ren to school. Alternative programmes will be put into place.

Friday: First round of devices ready for collection to the families that responded to the survey. At this stage one device per family. After the agreement has been signed.

Monday: roll out digital learning for all our students, those at home and those still at school.

Tuesday or Wednesday: Second round of devices ready for collection, hopefully each child will have a device.

I re-iterate THE SCHOOL IS NOT CLOSED!

I will continue to keep you updated.
