At this stage, until otherwise directed, we will be continuing with online learning next term. We have modified the delivery slightly, due to your input from the last survey and from what we experienced of what did and did not work in the first week of delivery.

You will receive a new timetable for Term Two. Please print off the timetable that is relevant to your child/ren. The reasons we are following a timetable is because it provides some structure for the students to follow and it provides set times for when the teachers are available to assist the students and to answer questions.

We realise and recognise how difficult it is for you at home, especially those of you with more than one child and especially those of you with younger children. Please be mindful that we understand if a student can't complete all the work and we do not want them to come under undue stress. You are welcome to complete the work outside the designated timetable. However, you need to be mindful that if you choose this route, the teachers of those lessons will not be available to answer any questions immediately outside the scheduled times. You will notice, in the new timetables, that we have re-introduced some of the non-core subjects such as Music, Home Economics, Art, Bible, Mandarin etc. As the term progresses and if we deem it necessary, we may introduce others. You will be receiving an online learning policy that covers the expectations of the school for staff, students and parents. This policy has been drawn up for the protection of all stakeholders. Please read through the policy and explain it to your child/ren, where necessary.
