Dear Parents/Carers,

After the most recent announcement from the Government concerning schools for Term Two. The plan for our school is as follows:

- We will be open for all students from Wednesday 29th April. It is your choice as a parent to decide whether your child/children are to attend school or learn from home.
- For week one and two, all learning will be online for both those at school and those at home, following the online timetable sent out at the end of last term.
- Unless things change and we receive different directives our aim is to return to, as normal as possible, from week 3, following the original class timetable. Those who choose to keep their child/ren at home will then receive recorded lessons that have been taught to their class.
- We strongly encourage the Year 11 and 12 students to return to school from the first day of school. Wednesday 29th April.
- Social distancing will be in place, as far as is practical at all times and we will be following a very strict cleaning regime throughout the day.
- If you choose to send your child/ren back to school, please send them with their borrowed school devices, if you borrowed one, and ensure that it is fully charged. We will be asking all those returning to school after week two, to hand in borrowed devices.

I hope that this letter has addressed questions you may have had. I will continue to update you if the situation changes.
